



FLYOVERS PROJECT



OVERVIEW

After the Mobility Authority opened 290 Toll in 2014, the number of commuters that recognized the convenience of the new roadway surpassed our projections. This high demand led to traffic congestion at the frontage road intersection of 290 Toll and SH 130 (a TxDOT-operated toll road). Without a safe and efficient link between the two roadways, mobility and safety are compromised during the morning rush hour for southbound SH 130 drivers trying to head westbound on 290 Toll.

KEEPING CENTRAL TEXAS MOVING

The Mobility Authority will construct three flyovers to bridge the two toll facilities together. This will give drivers a safe and efficient, free-flowing direct connection and free up capacity on the frontage road intersection underneath the toll facilities. One flyover already exists from eastbound US 290 to northbound SH 130. Building three additional flyovers is essential to achieving greater mobility for all drivers.



FLYOVERS PROJECT

The Flyovers Will Enhance Mobility By:

- ▶ Reducing potential for high speed rear end collisions on SH 130
- ▶ Eliminating queueing of vehicles on the southbound and northbound mainlanes of SH 130
- ▶ Saving about \$5 million a year for the traveling public in time as well as fuel and vehicle costs
- ▶ Attracting over 5,000 vehicles per day from parallel facilities, thereby providing additional congestion relief to other corridors
- ▶ Increasing the average speed by up to 40 miles per hour
- ▶ Shifting approximately 67 percent of vehicles off the southbound SH 130 frontage road and onto the new flyover ramp to westbound 290 Toll
- ▶ Reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 1,020 metric tons annually
- ▶ Attracting economic development opportunities to the region by way of enhanced local and regional connectivity



DID YOU KNOW?

Former Mobility Authority board member **James H. Mills** was an advocate for the 290/130 Flyovers; the north-to-west and south-to-west flyover bridges will be named in his honor.
