



# TRAVIS COUNTY PROGRAM FACT SHEET



## SAFETY PRIORITIES FOR THE COUNTY

The County has enlisted the services of the Mobility Authority to expedite the delivery of two projects in the Capital Improvement Program that are high safety priorities:

1. Elroy Road from McAngus Road to Kellam Road
2. Ross Road from Pearce Lane to Heine Farm Road

These roads serve as routes to the Del Valle schools and Elroy Road is prone to flooding from Dry Creek, making emergency evacuation and emergency services difficult.

## ELROY ROAD

The two-lane Elroy Road stretches 1.12 miles from McAngus Road to Kellam Road and will be reconstructed into a five-lane urban arterial with a continuous center turn lane. The project also includes bike lanes and sidewalks in each direction, enhancing

safety for all users. The project will mitigate flooding issues to allow safe access and evacuation when needed, as well as serve traffic generated by the nearby Circuit of the Americas facility.

## ROSS ROAD

The Mobility Authority will expand the 0.8-mile section of Ross Road spanning from Pearce Lane to Heine Farm Road. The existing two-lane road will be reconstructed into a four-lane urban arterial, and includes bike lanes and sidewalks in both directions. The upgraded roadway will improve mobility for nearby neighborhoods as well as enhance access to nearby schools.
