Project Description/Background - The area surrounding the MoPac and Lake Austin Boulevard intersection, including Atlanta Street and W. 5th and 6th Streets, is highly traveled by both pedestrian and vehicular traffic. The area is unsightly due to the general deterioration of the infrastructure and lack of vegetation under the MoPac and Union Pacific Railroad bridges.

The Mobility Authority has identified aesthetic and landscape improvements to visually enhance this area. The improvements include cleaning, painting, and repair of curb, walls and railing; new striping and thermoplastic treatment for crosswalks and medians; and planting in the bare areas under the bridges.
