

**TOLL EXEMPTION
AFFIDAVIT & AGREEMENT**

As a user of a toll exemption, identified through license plate recognition permitted to this entity by the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (“CTRMA”), I have read the applicable portion of Section 370.177 (a-1), Texas Transportation Code, Section 301.004, CTRMA Toll Policy and Section 503(b) of the Master Indenture authorizing the Mobility Authority’s outstanding revenue bonds, both of which cover free passage of CTRMA toll roads by authorized vehicles.

Section 370.177 (a-1), Texas Transportation Code, authorizes the board to waive payment of a toll or may authorize payment of a reduced toll for any vehicle or class of vehicles. Section 301.004 of the CTRMA Toll Policy, outlines vehicle exemptions that utilize CTRMA toll facilities.

The CTRMA has a provision in their Master Indenture which allows for free passage for “Authorized Vehicles” applicable under Section 370.177 (a-1), Texas Transportation Code.

By providing applicable license plate numbers of vehicles for toll exemption consideration, I and all employees using the CTRMA toll roads agree to abide by the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement.

I confirm the license plates permitted for toll exempt status are not for personal or private use and may not be transferred, loaned, or otherwise used by anyone other than the authorized users.

I will provide regular updates to the license plate and electronic toll tag list whenever a new vehicle is put into service and/or a vehicle license plate is removed or taken out of service.

(if applicable) Public Transportation and Van Pools are required to provide updated fleet information within 30 days of a change. I acknowledge failure to update this information may result in valid toll fees which may not be waived.

The CTRMA, at its sole discretion, may audit compliance with the terms of this agreement at any given time. I agree my entity will fully cooperate with the CTRMA when audit is conducted.
