Mobility Authority's Commitment to Road Safety

Joe Williams, the [Traffic and Incident Management Center](#) Supervisor, recently served on the panel at the [2025 IBTTA Maintenance, Engineering & Roadway Operations Workshop](#) in Detroit. Representing the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, Joe shared practical strategies and technological innovations that improve roadway safety.

Recently, the Mobility Authority extended its contract with Rekor Command®, state-of-the-art roadway intelligence technology. The Mobility Authority's implementation of this technology has led to a 324% increase in incident detection data, 11-minute faster average response time, and the detection of 641 incidents on Texas roadways monthly, on average. The Mobility Authority will continue to use this technology and best practices to enhance our commitment to keeping Central Texas roads safer and smarter.



Vehicle Theft Prevention Month

July was Vehicle Theft Prevention Month, a reminder that safeguarding your vehicle is especially critical during summer, when thefts tend to surge. These tips can go a long way in keeping your vehicle secure year-round.

- If you like it, lock it. Secure all doors and windows, even during quick stops.
- Park in well-lit, high-traffic areas.
- Hide your valuables and put any bags in trunks.
- Never leave keys inside, even while fueling.
- Don't leave your car running unattended.
- Consider anti-theft tools like wheel locks, dash cameras or GPS trackers.
