Discuss and consider approving an agreement with Sigma Surveillance, LLC dba STS360 for purchase of speed awareness devices to support the Mobility Authority's roadway safety program

Project Background: The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration notes that 11,288 people died in 2024 in speeding-related traffic deaths. This correlates to 29% of all traffic fatalities. Speeding endangers not only the life of the speeder, but everyone on the road around them, including law enforcement officers.

The Mobility Authority has identified areas along specific corridors where higher speeds are prevalent. To improve safety by increasing driver awareness of their speed, the Authority plans to purchase and deploy speed awareness devices. These signs are designed to be informative to all drivers, displaying the posted speed limit as well as current speed of vehicles, and will increase the awareness display for drivers who are travelling over a designated speed by displaying a message ("Slow Down") urging drivers to be aware of their high speed and take action.

These devices are intended for educational and awareness purposes only and will not feed into law enforcement systems.

Action Requested: The Mobility Authority studied several different manufacturers providing speed awareness devices. Requirements included the ability to display real-time vehicle speed, display a message after a speed threshold has been breached, be clearly visible at highway/expressway speeds, and be easily relocatable. After evaluating several different devices, it was determined that Wanco, Inc. provided the most

comprehensive and best value solution to meet the Authority's needs.

The current request seeks approval to enter into a new agreement with Sigma Surveillance LLC, dba STS360 for procurement of three (3) speed awareness devices manufactured by Wanco, Inc., administered through STS360 DIR Contract #DIR-CPO-6157. The associated not to exceed cost of \$59,152.50 includes a 10% contingency as well as costs related to freight and a three-year onsite parts and labor warranty. It is important to note that only one device will be procured in fiscal year 2027.

**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH SIGMA SURVEILLANCE LLC, DBA STS360,
FOR PROCUREMENT OF SPEED AWARENESS DEVICES**

WHEREAS, the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority (“Mobility Authority”) has identified specific roadways where higher vehicle speeds are prevalent and pose safety risks to the traveling public, and seeks to improve safety by increasing driver awareness of their speed; and

WHEREAS, to improve safety and increase driver awareness, the Mobility Authority has determined that it is necessary to procure and deploy speed awareness devices capable of displaying real-time vehicle speeds and alerting drivers who exceed a designated speed threshold; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating several different speed awareness devices, the Mobility Authority determined that Wanco, Inc. provides the most comprehensive and best value solution to meet the Mobility Authority's needs; and

WHEREAS, Sigma Surveillance LLC, dba STS360 ("STS360"), is an authorized vendor for Wanco, Inc. speed awareness devices under Texas Department of Information Resources (“DIR”) Contract No. DIR-CPO-6157; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 2054.0565 and Mobility Authority Policy Code Section 401.008, the Mobility Authority may utilize procedures established by the DIR to procure goods and services through DIR cooperative contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director recommends entering into an agreement with STS360 for the procurement of speed awareness devices in an amount not to exceed \$59,152.50, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors hereby approves the agreement with Sigma Surveillance LLC, dba STS360, for the procurement of speed awareness devices manufactured through DIR Contract No. DIR-CPO-6157, in an amount not to exceed \$59,152.50 attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Director is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Sigma Surveillance LLC, dba STS360, for the procurement of speed awareness devices in an amount not to exceed \$59,152.50 through its cooperative contract with the Texas Department of Information Resources.
